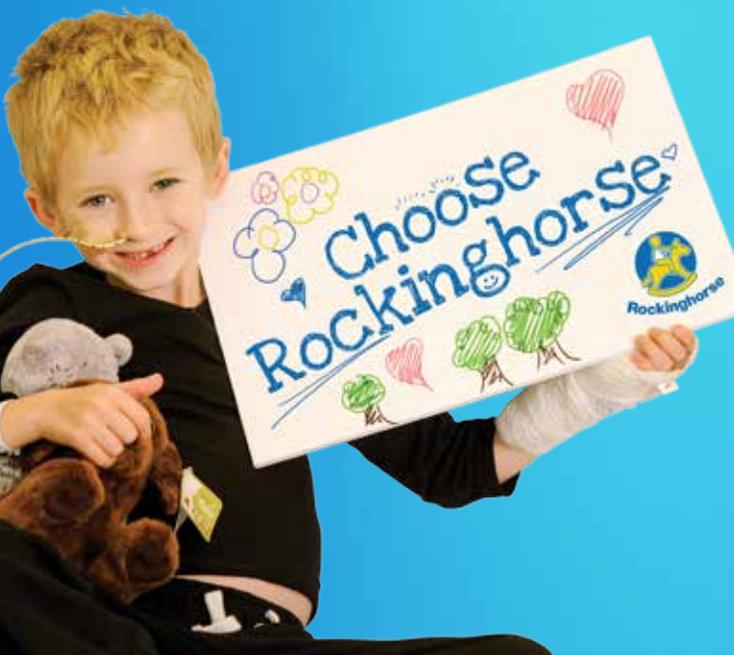

How to play

It couldn't be easier...

A) Send in your completed standing order details on the attached application form, including selecting your four numbers between 1 and 31 (inclusive) for each entry. Or...

B) Pay regularly through your local door to door collector. We will confirm your entries in writing or email. Once your payment has been received you will be in the next draw. For standing order entries, payments are taken on the 1st or 15th of the month.

What are the prizes?

The first prize starts at £1,000 for anyone matching their four numbers with those drawn. If there is more than one entry matching the four numbers, then the jackpot is split. All players matching three numbers win £25.

If no one matches the four numbers, the jackpot increases by £100 and is carried forward to the next week. If the jackpot reaches £5,000 then a special draw will take place to guarantee a winner. After the jackpot has been won, the prize is reset to £1,000.

When do the draws take place?

Draws take place each week on a Wednesday (from 1 October 2014). The results will be published online at www.rockinghorse.org.uk.

All winners will receive payment automatically by cheque so there is no need to claim.

What happens to the money we raise?

Funds received from the Rockinghorse Lotto will help us continue our work making life better for sick children and their families. Every penny raised is distributed locally to provide cutting-edge medical equipment and support services, while ensuring that children are treated in an environment that is better suited to their needs.

Rockinghorse was founded in 1967 by Dr Trevor Mann, a leading paediatric consultant who strived to improve specialist paediatric care for the children and babies of Sussex. Dr Mann began an appeal for research into children's diseases and raised the funds to establish one of the first units outside of London with incubators for neonatal patients. This led to the creation of both the Rockinghorse charity, and the specialist Trevor Mann Baby Unit at the Royal Sussex County Hospital in Brighton.



We are the official fundraising arm of the Royal Alexandra Children's Hospital (the Alex) and vital supporter of the Trevor Mann Baby Unit (TMBU) and the Special Care Baby Unit (SCBU) at the Princess Royal Hospital in Haywards Heath. We also provide funding to local respite centres and special needs schools throughout the area.

Proceeds from the Rockinghorse Lotto will help our fundraising projects which currently include providing new toys and sensory equipment for the Play Team at the Alex, funding a weekly support group for teenagers living with long-term illnesses and donating new ventilators for the High Dependency Unit.

We also provide an ongoing research grant to the TMBU for clinical studies into premature births, and we are providing new cots for the SCBU in Haywards Heath.

Poppy's story



Poppy Howell, 11 months, was admitted to the Children's A&E Department at the Alex with acute breathing problems and an extremely high temperature. The new Optiflow machines funded by Rockinghorse made a huge difference to Poppy's treatment, as mum Jade explains:

"Having Poppy rushed to hospital was so scary. Her breathing was rapid and wheezy and I thought she was going to die, that is how poorly she looked. In A&E, Poppy hated the big oxygen mask so much, it made her cry. She also kept trying to take it off her face and it was so difficult and stressful.

The next day we were moved to the High Dependency Unit and Poppy was put on to the Optiflow machine. The difference it made was immediate and so much better. Poppy was diagnosed with bronchiolitis and spent the next three days on Optiflow. She began to eat and play, and could move around normally without having to come off the oxygen which was helping her to recover so well. She could also still have her nebuliser medication.

Everyone at the Alex was absolutely brilliant. We thought Poppy would be spending her first birthday in hospital, but thanks to the amazing treatment available, and the cutting-edge equipment funded by Rockinghorse, I got to take her home in time to celebrate with her friends and family – thank you so much!"
